- **Read Romans 1:6-7**
 - *Romans 1:6-7 “And you are included among those Gentiles who have been called to belong to Jesus Christ. I am writing to all of you in Rome who are loved by God and are called to be his own holy people. May God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ give you grace and peace.”*
- What does BELONG mean to you?
- BELONG is key to CBC’s Mission Statement
 - Because Satan has been telling each of us lies for too long
 - How do you recognize YOU BELONG no matter your struggles or issues?
 - YOU BELONG because of Christ
 - It changes everything, have you let it change your opinion of yourself?
- **RECOGNIZE YOUR REALITY**
 - You are a Saint. You are Holy.
 - *Ephesians 2:19 “So now you Gentiles are no longer strangers and foreigners. You are citizens along with all of God’s holy people. You are members of God’s family.”*
 - Do you believe this about yourself?
 - Hint: regardless of what you think about yourself you are! So start to live it and accept it.
- Paul’s “hello” in Romans has a lot of information. Paul starts with these 7 verses so that all reading this would understand the foundation first.
 - You have been “Called” = BELONG
 - You are “Saints” = HOLY
